

Duniway Stockroom Corp. Position Statement on:
RoHS and WEEE.

Revised August 15, 2005

1. **RoHS** (Reduction of Hazardous Substances) is an EU initiative to reduce the level of hazardous substances in products distributed in their countries.

Key substances to be reduced/monitored are:

Pb (Lead), Cd (Cadmium), Hg (Mercury), CrVI (Hexavalent Chromium), PBB (Polybrominated Biphenyl) and PBDE (Polybrominated Biphenyl Ether).

The RoHS directive applies to products “placed on the market” after July 1, 2006.

Specifically exempted, at this time, from compliance are

- a. Category 9: Monitoring and Control Equipment - Laboratory and Industrial Equipment.

- b. Equipment operating above 1,500 VDC.

These exemptions appear to cover all electronic equipment which Duniway Stockroom sells, distributes or produces.

RoHS Position: Duniway Stockroom Corp. is concerned about environmental issues and we intend to do our best to comply with reasonable directives. We have begun working with our suppliers and internal processes to assure that the use of the specified hazardous substances is minimized or eliminated. We will also continue to monitor the progress of RoHS in the EU, the similar efforts of other countries and the exemptions that apply to our products.

2. **WEEE** (Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment) is an EU Directive, being implemented by legislation in each of the 25 member states to assure recovery and responsible recycling of electrical and electronic equipment.

The WEEE directives were scheduled to become effective August 13, 2005; however, UK, the member state with the most advanced implementation has announced a delay until July 1, 2006.

Producers and distributors are responsible for assuring that 100% of their products are recovered and responsibly recycled at end of life.

Specifically exempted, at this time, from compliance, is equipment operating above 1,500 VDC. This exemption appears to cover ion pump controls.

WEEE Position: Duniway Stockroom Corp. is concerned about environmental issues and we intend to do our best to comply with reasonable directives. In its current form, full implementation of WEEE appears to be some time away. However, we will develop an environmentally responsible recycling plan, label products possibly covered by WEEE and use our web-site to inform our customers about responsible recycling practices. We will continue to monitor the progress of WEEE in the EU, the similar efforts of other countries and the exemptions that apply to our products.
